We are available in the area of orientation for individual interviews with prospective students with disabilities or with LSD who are interested in our degree programs.

We are available for individual interviews with students with disabilities or with LSD of our Degree Courses regarding specific situations in order to identify the best solutions for each problem, also interfacing with the teachers.
